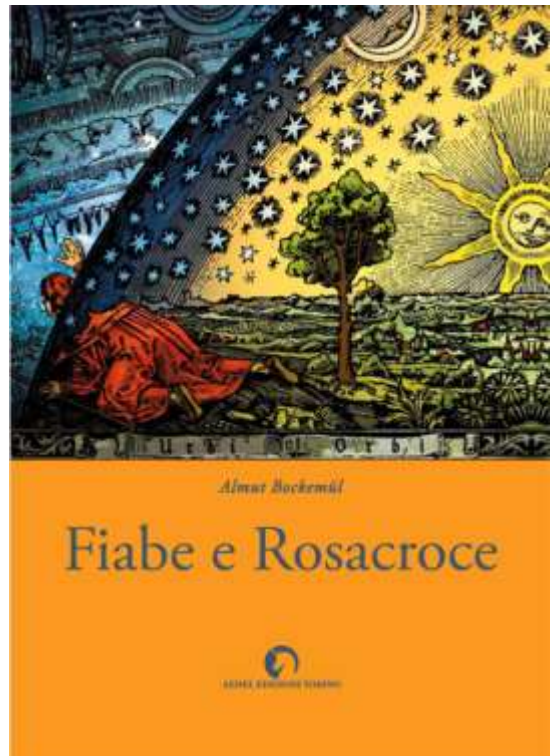

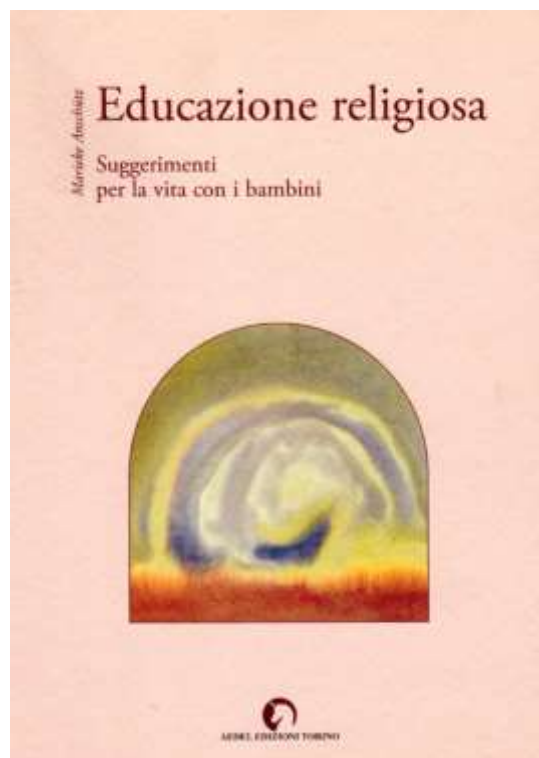
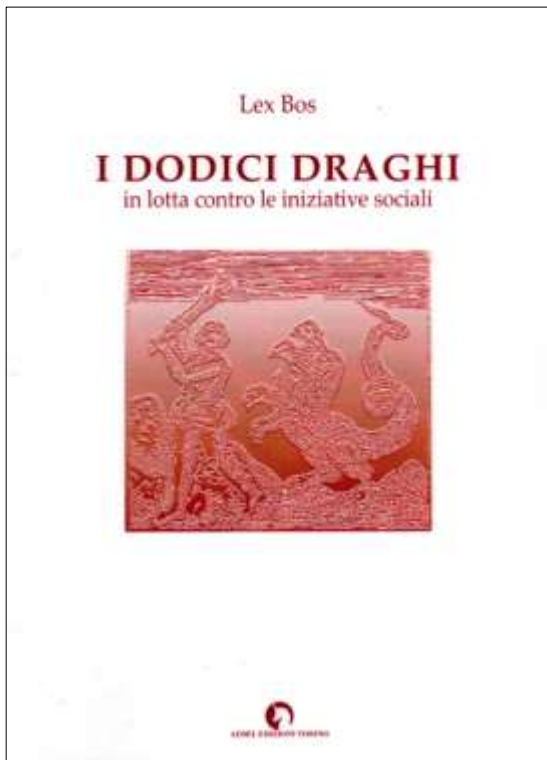

# Functional Morphology

The Dynamic Wholeness  
of the Human Organism

What can the human body tell us when we attempt to understand all the qualities and functional interrelationships of the living whole? Author J.W. Rohen, professor emeritus of anatomy (Marburg/Lahn 1964-1974, Erlangen-Nürnberg 1974-1991) has been tackling this question for decades. The insights he has achieved on the basis of Goethe's phenomenological method are accessibly described and brilliantly illustrated in this book.

Beginning with the division of the human organism into three functional domains, Rohen reveals the unique characteristics and qualities of organ systems by describing them in terms of their inherent threefold functional dynamics and interrelationships, often with reference to their ontogeny and phylogeny. This book significantly supplements and expands the concepts of general anatomy and offers a new basis for approaching the interaction of body and soul. It not only conveys information but also awakens the reader's astonishment and joy at the unique nature of the human being.

"We will arrive at a deeper understanding of life functions only when we learn to assess them with respect to the body in its entirety; that is, when we stop attempting to arrive at the whole by beginning with reductionist minutiae. Let's see what happens when we take the opposite approach: we will attempt to understand the whole before proceeding to the parts. We will discover that the whole is reflected in all subsequent structures in the hierarchy."
